- 3 Take Hwy. 116 West Exit to Sebastopol then West on Hwy. 12 (Bodega Hwy.) to North on Coast Hwy. 1 28 miles
- 4 Take the East Washington St. Exit follow the signs West through Petaluma. Take this road all the way to Bodega Bay 30 miles

Get to know our area

Rich in History...

The Bodega Bay Area is full of legends of the Russians at Fort Ross to tales of explorers discovering this coastal paradise then settling in to raise livestock, farm wheat and harvest the Redwood forests.

The first to inhabit this area were the Native American Coast Miwok who lived in the hills and along the shores of Sonoma County for thousands of years. Their diet consisted of deer, rabbits, salmon, and other riches from the ocean. Acorns, which are full of protein, were turned into types of mush, similar to Hawaiian poi. The Spanish and Russians contributed to their decimation, however, when California became a state, it legalized genocide against "Indians". Thankfully, the Coast Miwok survived and today they still practice their traditions, although they no longer live in the hills around Bodega Bay.

In 1775, Lt. Don Juan Francisco de la Bodega y Quadra dropped anchor in the bay then sent word back home that brought settlers from Mexico. As the bay area was developed, they established warehouses along the shore, called bodegas. No one knows for sure which bodega gave the bay its name.

BODEGA BAY was established as a port by the Russian settlers who came here seeking a mild climate to raise food crops and fur trading for their Alaskan settlements.

The protected port quickly became the import and export center for the Sonoma Coast, and established itself as a fishing village with a complete array of delectable sea fare. People now come from all over to enjoy crab and salmon fresh from the sea and to explore the variety of shops that line Coast Highway 1.

BODEGA (8 miles inland from Bodega Bay) attracts people from far and wide who come to see where Alfred Hitchcock filmed *The Birds*, and the historic 150 year old St.
Teresa's Church. The main street is lined with eclectic antique shops and art galleries that pour their goods onto the sidewalk.

JENNER is the beautiful little town that nestles into the hills where the Russian River meets the Pacific Ocean. There was a time around the turn of the century when people took the train to this tiny coastal town. People from all parts of the world continue to visit.

VALLEY FORD became a farming town specializing in oats, potatoes and sheep, and was put on the map in 1972 when thousands came to see the artist, Cristo's Running Fence meandering across its hills. A delightful "bend in the road" to visit and have a bite to eat.

FREESTONE became the hub of the entire west county while the railroad was being built between Sausalito to the south and Cazadero to the north. Thousands of people came to live here, establishing the first schoolhouse in 1853 and the area's first steam saw mills. Today, it's an exquisite coastal valley with beautiful historic buildings offering unique goods and services in a relaxing atmosphere.

OCCIDENTAL was established by settlers coming to log the giant Redwoods and expanded dramatically in 1876 when the North Pacific Coast Railroad came to town. Today it's famous for the Italian restaurants, antique and craft shops as well as its Chamber Music and Arts programs.

FORT ROSS is eleven spectacular miles up the coast from Jenner. Along the cliffs above the sea, the old Russian fort still stands, carefully preserved for all to see how the Russians established an entire community far from home. Fort Ross State Historic Park is open every day from 10AM to 4:30PM. www.fortross.org
